Administrative Officers Committee (4) Councillors

The function of this committee is to:

- (i) *Consider all nominations for the position of Administrative Officer and to investigate the qualifications and credentials of candidates for election as Administrative Officer.*
- (ii) *Report to the Council as to the suitability of candidates for election to Administrative Officer positions.*
- (iii) *Recommend to the Council as to whether or not a vacancy for a position of Administrative Officer should be filled.*

Annual Conference Agenda Committee (4) Councillors

The term of office for these Federation Restricted Committees is two years until March Council 2013

Aboriginal Members Committee (10) Aboriginal Education Co-ordinator, Aboriginal Education Assistant (1 City, 1 Country), Aboriginal Education Consultative Group (2) + 10 to be elected by Council.

Open to members who are on the Aboriginal Members' Roll.

Aboriginal Education Committee (6) Aboriginal Coordinator + 6 (**at least three of whom will be Aboriginal teachers**)

This Committee will have the responsibility to develop policies, strategies and campaign action designed to achieve change and force governments to improve the educational success of Aboriginal students in NSW.

Anna Stewart Program (6) Women's Coordinator, General Secretary [or her nominee] + 6 Women Councillors

Anti Racism Policy Committee (5) Councillors

Central Schools Committee (5) from Central Schools

Class Sizes Committee (4) Councillors

Corrective Services Committee (5) from Corrective Services TA

Distance Education Committee (6) to comprise of 6 members who are currently working in the distance education field + 1 city and 1 country organiser

Eric Pearson Study Grant (4)

Finance Committee (4) senior officers, custodians, accountant ex-officio and 4 members elected by Council.

Gay, Lesbian, Bisexual, Transgender Committee (6) 3 men + 3 women who identify as gay, lesbian, bisexual or transgender – meeting twice a year

Legal Cases Committee (4) 5 welfare officers, 2 Executive members plus AGS (Research & Industrial) and 4 members elected by Council

Officers, Consultants & Advisers Committee (5)

Project Officers Committee (3) Councillors, the President, the General Secretary, the Trade Union Training Officer, the Membership and Training Officer and 3 Councillors (**2 with less than 10 years teaching**).

Executive decision of 5 December 2006 states that a new process be established for selecting Federation Project Officers and nominees be asked to submit their nomination to this committee.

Recruitment and Retention Committee (4) Councillors, 2 Executive members, the General Secretary or nominee, 1 Senior Officer, the Membership and Training Officer, AGS (Schools), AGS Post Schools), AGS (Communications and Administration) and AGS Research and Industrial)

Rules and Structures Committee (8) Councillors, Presidential Officers, the General Secretary, AGS (Communications and Administration) and 8 Councillors (at least 2 from Zone 3 and no more than 2 being officers)

Sam Lewis Peace Committee (5)

Small Schools Committee (5)

Special Education Committee (5) at least 2 to be from non metropolitan Associations.

This Committee, elected by Council, shall be restricted to members currently in receipt of children with disabilities allowance and Support Teachers Learning Difficulties. The Committee shall consist of five (5) members and an officer attached. At least two members are to be members of non metropolitan Associations.

Technology Support Committee (5)

Trainee Teachers Scholarship Committee (3) Councillors, the General Secretary or nominee, an officer and 3 Councillors

Tree Levy Committee (4) + the General Secretary

VET Workload Committee (4) – 2 School VET Teachers and 2 TAFE Teachers

Women's Committee (6) + Women's Coordinator

Executive decision of 5 December 2006 states that the Women's Committee be established to replace the EEO Ad Hoc Committee and consist of 6 women members elected by Council.

The term of these Federation Restricted Committees is for the period of time it takes to complete the work currently before them.

Dignity and Respect in the Workplace (5) to comprise of 2 school members, 2 post school members and one Executive member

Excessive Teacher Workload Committee (6) 1 Executive + 6 teachers – 2 primary, 2 secondary and 2 TAFE, at least half of whom shall be women
