TEACHERS CAMPAIGN FOR EXTRA GONSKI FUNDING IN THE BLUE MOUNTAINS.

Teachers Federation President Maurie Mulheron will be urging voters to support candidates who back the extension of Gonski needs-based education funding in a series of campaign events in the Blue Mountains today.

A Gonski mobile billboard will be taking the message to teachers and parents in the area today, Monday 30 May 2016.

Mr Mulheron said while Labor had committed to fund the final two years of the Gonski plan, the Federal Coalition was leaving schools \$3 billion short and instead was prioritising tax cuts for the wealthy over education funding.
