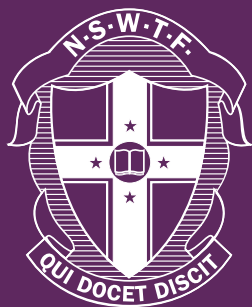

MEMBERSHIP PAYMENT OPTIONS

A variety of payment methods are available for part-time casual teachers, assessors and education support officers. For members working less than 13.5 hours per week, we recommend payment by payroll deduction.

The rate is

\$572.98 per calendar year.

The equivalent rates for this amount are as follows:

Fortnightly \$22.04

Monthly \$47.75

3 months \$143.25

6 months \$286.49

Or through payroll deductions at the rate of
\$0.80 cents per hour worked.

PAYMENT OPTIONS

OPTION 1:

Payroll deductions for part-time casual teachers, assessors and education support officers is \$0.80 cents per hour worked per fortnight. The capped amount per calendar year is \$572.98. Members will be refunded for payments above this amount.

OPTION 2:

Direct debit from your cheque or savings account. Membership fees will be debited from your bank account each fortnight.

OPTION 3:

Automatic credit card payments. Your Visa or Mastercard will be debited each month/fortnight.

OPTION 4:

Upfront payment of 12 months' fees. Payments can be made by cheque, money order or credit card. Payment should be made out to "NSW Teachers Federation". You will then be sent an account for all future payments.
