DECLARATION OF AUTHORISED OFFICER in accordance with Regulation 126 *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009*

ALTERATION OF OTHER RULES OF ORGANISATIONS in accordance with section 159 of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009*

I, John Dixon of 23-33 Mary Street Surry Hills NSW am the Branch Secretary of the Australian Education Union New South Wales Teachers Federation Branch and am authorised to give this notice of particulars of alterations to the rules of the Australian Education Union New South Wales Teachers Federation Branch and to make this declaration as required by Regulation 126 of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009*.

1. I declare that the alterations were made in accordance with the rules of the Australian Education Union New South Wales Teachers Federation Branch
2. The particulars of the rule alterations are attached to this declaration and labelled 'Schedule A'.
3. The actions taken under the rules to make this alteration were as follows:
 - (a) On 8 August 2020, the Branch Secretary gave notice to the Branch Council of the proposed rule change to Branch rule 4 (7).
 - (b) The Branch Secretary sent a notice on August 12 2020 including a copy of the proposed rule changes to each Association.
 - (c) The Branch Council meeting was held via Zoom on 12 September 2020.
 - (d) 216 Councillors were present at the meeting at which the rule changes were considered. As such the meeting was quorate.
 - (e) The changes to Rule 4 (7) were declared carried by a majority of members present

Schedule A

Existing Rule

4 - SUBSCRIPTIONS AND LEVIES

- (7) Subject to sub-rule (6), a member shall become unfinancial if his or her subscriptions, levies or fines remain unpaid for a period in excess of two months after the subscription, levy or fine becomes payable.

Proposed New Rule (changes in italics)

4 - SUBSCRIPTIONS AND LEVIES

- (7) Subject to sub-rule (6), a member shall become unfinancial if his or her subscriptions, levies or fines remain unpaid for a period in excess of *sixty (60) days* after the subscription, levy or fine becomes payable
