Women participants will develop the knowledge and skills to feel confident to undertake union leadership positions. At the end of this course participants will be able to identify different leadership roles within the union as well as the skills and attributes that are required for these roles. Participants will be able to interpret ethical roles and responsibilities of leadership within the workplace and wider communities, and the union. The course aims to enable participants to create opportunities to develop and contribute to productive and supportive networks for women’s empowerment.

This course will run over three days. During the first two days participants will reflect on their union leadership goals and aspirations to identify an aspect of their leadership to focus on. Participants will then design a mini action research project to undertake based on this. Participants will return for the third day later in the year to report on their project and share experiences, outcomes, and strategies to complete the course. **Participants must complete all three days.**
